

October 19th COVID Protocols

- 1. Masks are to be worn by every person entering the facility over the age of 2 years
- 2. All participants must wear a mask at all times, until using such a covering becomes intolerable during their activity
- 3. One spectator per participant will be permitted in the facility, the spectators need to enter with the participant
 - a. If a household is participating in the same practice time, one spectator is allowed per family.
 - b. Non-participating siblings are discouraged from entering the building.
 - c. Spectators must wear masks at all times and observe social distancing while in the ice arena.
 - d. Bleachers are clearly marked for appropriate social distancing
- 4. Group sizes may not exceed 30 total participants
- 5. Doors will open 30 minutes prior to scheduled practice time
- 6. You must check in with staff in the office regarding your reason for attending the sports complex
- 7. 10 hockey participants to a locker room only
- 8. No showering is allowed. Locker room bathrooms are kept locked.
- 9. User groups MUST use the assigned locker room
 - a. Locker Rooms will be disinfected between user groups
- 10. At the end of the practice participants have 15 minutes to leave the building
- 11. Participants need to enter, and exit on appropriate sides of the facility in order to reduce contact with next incoming group
- 12. Water bottles are to be brought individually and labeled clearly of participant name and placed separately from other participants.
 - a. Drinking fountain is turned off
- 13. Bathroom facilities and general lobby are available for spectators however, participants and spectators must be diligent about remaining in their designated areas
